Don Lee Announces Run for House District 52B

Eagan, MN – Don Lee, 35 year Eagan resident, software engineer, small business owner, parent and local activist, today announced he is running for the Minnesota House seat in District 52B.

Don said: “I have always lived in Minnesota, and I love it here. We are still a state that works, but our state government has grown too big, too powerful, and too costly. State government works best when it is frugal, minimal, and stable.”

Don continued: “Today, Minnesota government is none of those. We have seen repeated cycles of deficit and surplus. Deficit crises have driven taxes up, and businesses out. Each surplus has ratcheted up state spending. It’s time to stop the roller coaster.”

Don says state government needs to focus on what is essential, and do those things well, not try to solve every problem with a government solution.

Don has lived in Eagan since 1980, holding engineering positions with Sperry, Cray Research, and other local firms. He has also run a small computer services business since 1998. Don and his wife Connie raised 3 children in Eagan, and have been active in local politics, and supporting local schools. This is his second run for Minnesota house in district 52B.

Don is competing with Regina Barr for the endorsement of the district 52B Republicans at the local Republican convention on April 2nd.

District 52B includes Inver Grove Heights, Sunfish Lake, southern Mendota Heights and northern Eagan.
